As part of the Lord's Supper, we confess our common faith.

Confession of Faith *

Westminster Larger Catechism – Questions 137 & 138

Question: Which is the seventh commandment?

Answer: The seventh commandment is, Thou shalt not commit adultery.

Question: What are the duties required in the seventh commandment?

Answer: The duties required in the seventh commandment are, chastity in body, mind, affections, words, and behavior; and the preservation of it in ourselves and others; watchfulness over the eyes and all the senses; temperance, keeping of chaste company, modesty in apparel; marriage by those that have not the gift of continency, conjugal love, and cohabitation; diligent labor in our callings; shunning all occasions of uncleanness, and resisting temptations thereunto.

As instituted by our Lord, wine is the element used in the Lord's Supper to show forth His Blood on our behalf (Mark 14:23-25).

If, however, for reasons of conscience or health, you are unable to participate using wine, grape juice is provided on the outer ring of the tray.

Gluten-free wafers are provided on each bread tray.
