Westminster Larger Catechism – Question 4

For Further Reflection

1 Peter 3:13-17

"Sanctify Christ as Lord in Your Hearts & Be Ready to Give an Answer for the Hope Within You"

1.	From the passage what sort of opposition were these Christians facing (verses 14-16)?
2.	How does Peter help Christians not to be overcome with fear (verses 14 and 15)? When questioned, in what ways should believers respond to their persecutors (verse 15)?
3.	God commands us to do what is right, even if we suffer for it. Why is it we are tempted to do wrong in the midst of suffering? What will we accomplish by doing wrong?
4.	Memorize 1 Peter 3:15 (NASB 1995). "But sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, always being ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence."
